## Service Requirements

Students in the Confirmation Program must include service as an integral part of their preparation for the Sacrament of Confirmation.

Jesus, through His life, gave examples of serving others. On the night before He died, Jesus gave His friends both a great challenge and a wonderful promise. By washing their feet, like the lowliest servant, Jesus challenged His friends to bring love and service to all people, everywhere. (John 13:5-14). Today, we do that by word and action in our own lives.

Service is an action of good will that contributes to the welfare of others. Service is done free of charge and there should be no compensation for the service provided.

Candidates must complete the following:

### At Holy Name of Jesus Church

One (1) "Full Year" Service Commitment (Examples - Altar server, Choir, Usher, Prayer Line, Letters to Heaven, etc.)

### At Holy Name or in the Community

Five (5) "One Time" Service Commitments from either Church (Examples - Spring Festival, Christmas Project, Senior Prom, Santa Shop, Seder Meal etc.) or Community (Examples - Beach clean-up, coaching soccer etc.)

**\*\* Remember - If you sign up for a project and cannot attend, please call the coordinator as a courtesy and let them know you will not be attending and why.**

For "Full Year" Service Commitments", please indicate what the project is as soon as possible in the service journal and the date the service began and print your Supervisor's Name. We must review the one-year projects to make sure they qualify as a one-year project. The Supervisor and a Parent/Guardian must sign projects once the work is complete.

Bring your service journal with you to **all sessions** so we can help monitor your progress and help answer any questions you may have.
